## SOME EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH REPAIRS AT 1700 S, PLUS THE LOSS OF THE HOUSE AND THE LOT

Attached is a printout of some of the expenses we incurred in attempting to stop Aron Kulhavy, Kevin Byal and Keith Merchant from harassing me about the fire that burned our house at 1700 Ave S, due to the PROTECTION given by the City Manager and the police to the druggies who had invaded the house and appeared to be manufacturing and selling drugs at all hours of the day and night.

The printout is only a partial accounting of our expenses involved in what it took to get the city off our backs. The printout only shows certain expenses of \$38,343.70, but the list does not include my time dealing with the City and also my workers. It does not include Sue Ann's pay, Kristi Zeltner's pay, Jenny Zeltner's pay, Carlo Rodrigues' pay, the cost of maintaining three office buildings for the support staff, our accountant, our Private Investigator, vehicle costs and equipment time.

We conservatively believe that the direct costs and overhead associated with making the City get off our backs was over

\$100,000, plus being under financial duress plus the loss of the house and lot that we valued at \$600,000, so because of malfeasance on the part of the City Manager and the Chief of Police, our total loss was in excess of \$700,000, which we believe is conservative.

In the meantime there were substantial financial losses due to being forced to neglect maintenance of our rental properties that college students had torn up out of boredom during COVID, because our maintenance staff was pulled off of jobs to try to make the neighbors happy which was virtually impossible because at least two of the neighbors are members of the ruling oligarchy that hates me because I promote ethics in government, which makes bureaucrats and their sycophant followers form alliances against me. One of the complainers told our office manager that she delights in harassing me.

Every month that some of our houses needed to be repaired before they could be rented cost us thousands of dollars in lost rents.

## **CHRONOLOGY**

JANUARY 29, 2020: Arsonists blow up the meth lab at 1700 S.

There were witnesses to the arsonists starting the fire. The ruins of the house was a crime scene and were posted and off limits but the druggies kept going in and out and HPD would not take them to jail for trespassing and violating the orders for everyone to stay out.

Allegedly a State Fire Marshall visited the scene but I never got a report.

ATF Certified Fire Investigators should have conducted a thorough investigation, interviewing the witnesses and then arresting the arsonists.

MARCH 2, 2020: First paychecks were written for cleanup and repairs along with approximately 50 additional checks thousands of dollars..

NOVEMBER 4, 2020: We felt that we had the structure sufficiently stabilized to tackle other more critical projects. Up to that date we had not received any harassing or threatening letters from the City.

JANUARY 13, 2021: The first threatening letter was received. We were able to pull off of more critical jobs beginning in June 2021'through October 2021.

JANUARY 11, 2022: A second threatening letter was received.

AUGUST 24, 2022: We worked frantically and the complainer(s) were satisfied and the CASE WAS DISMISSED!!!

JANUARY 18, 2023: THE HARASSMENT REARED ITS UGLY HEAD AGAIN.

JANUARY 19, 2023: More harassment.

JANUARY 23, 2023: More harassment.

**FEBRUARY 8, 2023** 

APRIL 19, 2023: Last formal threat about 1700 S

JUNE 8, 2023: Just as predicted the City fabricated an unlawful threat about another property of ours which was in violation of the US CONSTITUTION.

### **BOTTOM LINE:**

The career of an ATF <u>special agent</u> is unique and one of the most challenging in federal law enforcement. ATF's highly trained agents are responsible for investigating violations of federal laws relating to firearms, explosives, arson, and alcohol and tobacco diversion. They rely on a combination of tactical, analytical and intelligence gathering skills to identify leads that will support criminal cases.

Special agents must be tough, both physically and mentally. They must also be able to handle rigorous training, personal risks, irregular hours, and extensive travel. Special agents are subject to reassignment to any <u>ATF office</u> in the United States or <u>overseas</u>. As of fiscal year 2020, there are 2,597 special agents currently working at ATF.

- Investigation of criminal acts relating to arson, alcohol, explosives, firearms and tobacco
- · Witness interrogation as part of criminal investigations
- Evidence collection, analysis and documentation
- · Search warrant execution
- Participation in interagency task forces

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Between 21-37 years of age
- · U.S. citizenship
- Able to obtain Top Secret clearance
- Eligible to work for the U.S. federal government
- Undergraduate degree, or experience, or a combination of education and experience
- · Valid driver's license

### **Application Process**

The entire process can take 12 months or longer from start to finish. Failure to pass any of the steps below may eliminate you from the hiring process.

### Online Application

- Login to USAjobs.gov and review the current special agent job announcements
- Learn how to build your resume
- · Submit your application by the deadline
- Receive notification of rankings

If qualified, you will receive a selection notice that you have passed the first phase, as well as a notification letter with more details on the written and physical tests.

### Written and Physical Tests

- Special agent written exam
- Special agent physical task test (PTT)

You must pass both tests to continue in the process.

### Interview and Background Check

- Panel interview
- Candidate letter notice
- Background investigation
- Polygraph test
- Medical exam
- Drug test

If you pass the panel interview, background investigation and all other tests, you will receive an "Enter on Duty" letter to report to training and new hire orientation.

### Polygraph

As a condition of employment, special agent applicants are required to successfully complete a polygraph examination. Applicants who have significant responses or who manipulate the polygraph process will be removed from the hiring process. Researching polygraph is unnecessary and highly discouraged, as many websites recommend methods that, if employed, may be deemed as a manipulation of the polygraph process.

### Training

Newly hired special agents report to the <u>Federal Law Enforcement Training Center</u> in Glynco, Georgia. Here, they must complete the 12-week Criminal Investigator Training Program, followed by the 15-week Special Agent Basic Training program.
