SUBJECT: Constant criminal trespass at 1700 Ave S. and Stolen Property

Today we received two more calls from unauthorized "roommates" of Heather Jones saying that she gave them permission to enter the house and collect their belongings.

People have been going in and out of the house since the night of the fire.

The neighbor at 1620 had called the police numerous times before and after the fire to report comings and goings at all hours of the night.

Attached are 15 Photos:

1. I purchased 6 stained glass windows from Heather to leave with the house to make it easier to rent after she would finally sell off her parents possessions and move in with family in E. Texas.

These windows disappeared before the fire and I suspect that Heather or other persons stole the windows and sold them for drugs.

The last time she sold some items before giving me a chance to bid on them she sold them to an antique shop downtown.

Hopefully they can be found.

2. Feb 17: 11:03 First photo after camera installed to catch trespassers.
3. Feb 21: 16:16 Photo shows face in the downstairs window.

4. Feb 21: 16:17 Photo shows object placed outside the window.
5. Feb 21: 16:19 Photo shows checkerboard or similar object placed outside the window.
6. Feb 21: 16:21 More objects placed outside the window.
7. Feb 21: 16:24 Another red object placed outside the window.
8. Feb 21: 16:32 Another object placed outside the window.
9. Feb 21: 21:09 I believe Mr. Angel called the police after observing trespassers.
10. Feb 21: 21:29 Police arrive to investigate.
11. Feb 21: 21:30 Police officer enters the house.
12. Feb 22: 10:19 Photo appears to be a trespasser entering the house.
13. Feb 22: 10:24 Police officer enters the house but apparently the trespasser was hiding somewhere.
14. Feb 22: 10:28 Photo of two officers
15. Feb 22: 10:32 Three officers in yard but apparently the trespassers were either hiding or were gone. Most of the items that had been placed outside the window are gone as well.

Just got another call from a man claiming to be a tenant. I cannot afford to allow anyone to enter the house due to the extreme danger and potential liability.

We have been telling people that if the police want them to enter the premises and will accompany them then that would be ok I suppose but how would anybody know if they actually own any possessions especially considering the fact that people have been going in and out of the house since January 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup> or for over three weeks.
